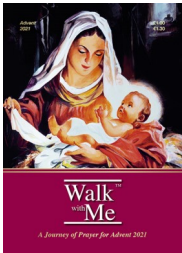
**Sunday Mass Programme** at Sacred Heart Saturday Vigil Mass at 6 pm and Sunday Mass at 11 am (also live-streamed).
