Spark Retreat –a Jesus Youth initiative. We welcome 30 young people who will journey on retreat here this weekend in the Scout Hut from our parish and Peterborough— may our young people be caught by the Spark of faith in their lives.

Pilgrim Cross - Midland Leg - we welcome pilgrims this weekend to our parish who will be staying in our Parish Hall and Clubroom. They are 25 pilgrims from around the country who will, during Holy Week walk 120 miles carrying a large wooden cross, reaching Walsingham on Good Friday. This has happened every year since the end of World War II except these Pandemic years. Each evening they stay in a different Church or Village Hall. When reaching Walsingham they will celebrate the Easter Triduum services together. Normally they would begin walking on Saturday, but due to a hall not being available they will instead undertake a walking interfaith pilgrimage here in Leicester visiting a Hindu Temple, a Mosque and a Gudwara in the streets around our church. They will then set off on their journey on Sunday morning. We hope they feel welcome with us.

Our Church gets full for the Triduum Services - please come early if you would like to be in church - we will use our halls for overflow with the service relayed.

Our prayers go with our Sikh friends who celebrate the festival of Vaisakhi and our Jewish friends who celebrate Passover during this week
