New Parish Priest from Mid September

Bishop Patrick has appointed Fr David Cain as our new Parish Priest serving the parishes of Sacred Heart & Our Lady's. The clustering plan for this area also includes St Joseph's.

Fr David is known to some in the parish as he served here for a Diaconate year before his Ordination to the Priesthood in 2003. He was then Assistant Priest here the year after.

Fr David has served at Nottingham Cathedral, as Diocesan Director for Vocations—based at St Peter's, Leicester, followed by further studies in Moral Theology at Leuven University in Belgium. He has been Chaplain to the Briars Youth Residential Centre, Co-ordinator of School Chaplains and Parish Priest of Coalville.

He has been a Chaplain on Pilgrim Cross (former Student Cross—a walking pilgrimage to Walsingham) and the Diocesan Pilgrimage to Walsingham.

He is presently Parish Priest of St Alban's Chaddesden, Derby with St Hugh's, Borrowash and the Church in Oakwood.

Fr David is also one of the co-ordinators in compiling our Diocesan report for the Synod 2023.

He is an extremely passionate Derby County Football Fan!

Fr John is delighted with the news and believes Fr David is ideally suited for the area and no doubt will revitalise our developments in the communities of Sacred Heart and Our Lady's.

Fr John will celebrate a Farewell Mass with Our Lady's parish community this Sunday, with his last weekend of Masses on Saturday 10th and 11th September. Fr John will move to the Presbytery at Earl Shilton, where the house is being prepared for him.

Fr David will begin his ministry among us on the weekend of the 17th and 18th September after leading a final pilgrimage with his Derby Parish to see the famous passion play in Oberammergau, Austria.

At the beginning of September Fr Emmanuel will take up his position as Parish Priest of Marple Bridge and New Mills. (Marple Bridge is the first parish that Fr John served in as a newly ordained priest.) Fr Prince will remain with us for hopefully the rest of the year as Assistant Priest resident at Our Lady's.

Fr John Daley IC will continue as Parish Priest at St Joseph's for as long as he is able. The Bishop has indicated that Fr David will then become Parish Priest of St Joseph's too.

Prayer for our priests - we would like to begin a monthly prayer calendar—where someone in our parish would pray for our priests each day of the month. We hope to begin this prayer ministry initiative in September as Fr John moves into his retirement, Fr Emmanuel takes up his new parish priest role and Fr David arrives as our new parish priest.
